**NOTICE TO THE PUBLIC**

**INTRODUCTION OF ELECTRONIC PAYMENT SYSTEM**

The Government of Tanzania would like to inform the public in general that it is in the process of establishing the electronic payment system with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> July 2010 via the BOT's Tanzania Interbank Settlement System (TISS). The new system requires all companies and individuals that are transacting with the Government ( i.e Ministries, Independent Departments and Regions) to submit their business and banking particulars in order to be included in the Government Integrated Financial Management System (IFMS).

The required particulars that need to be submitted are as listed below:

1. Bank Account number
2. Branch Code (Bic Number)
3. Bank Account Name
4. Account type

5. Business Registration number
6. Company Registration number
7. Tax Identification number (TIN)
8. Bank name and Branch name

In view of this notice, companies and individuals doing business with the Government are therefore requested to contact the Government offices which they are serving to collect the said forms of which they will be required to fill their particulars including the above mentioned ones.

The implementation of Electronic Payment System will be done in two phases:

- The first phase will involve all Ministries and Independent Departments operating under the Central Payment Office (CPO) in Dar es Salaam including Dar es Salaam Region which is also using the services provided by CPO.
- The second phase will involve other Ministries and all Regions that do not fall under the above mentioned category.
